ROLE SUMMARY

The Children's Coordinator is responsible for the administrative support to the Children's Ministry, especially in regards to Sundays. In addition to administrative needs, this role will support the Children's Ministry with other special projects and events as needed and as directed by the Children's Pastor.

SPECIFIC DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Scheduling
 - Coordinates and schedules volunteers via Planning Center Services
 - Addresses volunteer questions and needs
- Inventory & Supplies
 - Manages and maintains inventory supplies
 - Including but not limited to: cleaning supplies, snacks, & individual classroom needs (Nursery, Preschool, & Elementary)
- Sunday Services
 - Serves to support the Children's Ministry on Sundays as a staff presence to volunteers and other staff
 - Support volunteer teams (Welcome, Nursery, Preschool or Elementary) by tending to specific needs as directed by the Children's Pastor or Children's Director

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- Serves as lead teacher in Nursery or Preschool as needed for Bible teaching time and in songs, models for volunteers ways to engage children with scripture and in worship and prayer at early childhood
- Special Events
 - Provides support or leads coordination in a project manager role for special events
 - Including, but not limited to: midweek programs, seasonal holidays (i.e. Holy Week, Easter, Harvest Festival), evening programs, Parent Workshops, Vacation Bible School, etc.
