With a regular average in-person attendance of 1,000+ at our Sunday services, we continue to hope for and witness God's movement in San Francisco as it is in heaven.

We are seeking a Connections Pastor to join our Formation Team who is a pastoral leader that will guide people from first connection into meaningful discipleship. This role will oversee assimilation, next steps, and connection environments, helping our church embody the hospitality of Jesus and move intentionally along the Spiritual Growth Pathway. The ideal candidate will bring strategic clarity, relational presence, and pastoral depth to support the spiritual formation of those new to Reality SF or new to faith in Jesus.

As the Connections Pastor, you'll provide both strategic direction and pastoral care, designing and leading initiatives like *Welcome to Reality, Alpha*, and other key spaces that help people take their first or next step in the life of faith. You'll help shape a culture of servanthood and hospitality, equipping our church to be a place where people are not only invited in but also rooted in Christ-centered relationships. Through collaborative systems and thoughtful follow-up, you'll ensure that Reality San Francisco embodies gospel hospitality.

The ideal candidate will bring a blend of strategic clarity, relational warmth, and spiritual depth. You're someone who can think in systems but also sit with someone in their questions. You're energized by seeing people move from the margins to the center of church life — discovering belonging, deepening in discipleship, and participating in the life and mission of Reality San Francisco.

Primary Responsibilities

Outreach & Community Connection (30%)

- Lead connection environments such as Welcome to Reality, Eatups, and Alpha, cultivating spaces that are warm, curious, and invitational.
- Serve as a pastoral and relational guide for newcomers, helping them identify and take their next step in community or formation.
- Champion a churchwide culture of hospitality and relational presence, equipping teams and leaders to reflect the welcome of Christ.
- Help shape and sustain environments that make spiritual exploration and belonging accessible to people across all backgrounds and levels of faith engagement.

Assimilation Pathways & Next Steps (35%)

- Design and implement a clear and consistent assimilation pathway that helps people move from first-time connection to active participation.
- Coordinate and host milestone gatherings and follow-up experiences like Welcome to Reality, baptism courses, and newcomer integration spaces.
- Oversee systems such as The Card, email inquiries, and other front-facing channels to ensure timely, personalized, and thoughtful follow-up.
- Collaborate across ministries to integrate next steps into the broader Spiritual Growth Pathway, including groups, serving, and prayer.

Volunteer Leadership & Servanthood Culture (20%)

- Maintain a Sunday morning presence to personally connect newcomers and guests to next steps along the Spiritual Growth Pathway.
- Cultivate a culture of servant-hearted engagement by leading and overseeing volunteers who serve in newcomer and assimilation environments such as Welcome to Reality and Alpha.
- Recruit, train, and care for volunteer teams, ensuring each person is equipped to lead with warmth and clarity in relational and discipleship-focused spaces.
- Take responsibility for running and leading all connection events, courses, and spaces including logistics, volunteer coordination, and live facilitation to create welcoming environments.
- Provide ongoing coaching and development to volunteer leaders, helping them embody the values of presence, hospitality, and joyful service as they guide others into deeper engagement with Jesus and community.

Operational & Relational Support (15%)

- Lead planning and logistics for midweek and seasonal connection events
- Track and manage relevant budgets, resources, and supplies for newcomer integration and assimilation initiatives.
- Provide pastoral care through relational follow-ups and support of individuals taking steps into the community.
- Maintain organized communication systems and shared documents to support cross-departmental collaboration.
