

SELF-GUIDED MISSION MURAL WALK

The Mission has a rich tradition of vibrant street art with a real sense of “place.” Many murals serve as landmarks and local “alters” to the culture and the spirit of these streets.

Walk this self-guided tour alone in prayer or with others in thoughtful discussion – noticing themes, patterns, and the DNA of the art born in these alleyways.

SOME PROMPTS FOR CONSIDERATION

- In technique, in design, and in subject matter, ask “how” and “why” about each piece.
- Be curious and allow your eyes to notice detail – look at the micro and macro.
- Notice which pieces tend to get tagged, and which tend to be left alone.
- Do you notice any common themes? If so, what seems to be important to the artists and streets that these murals represent?
- Have you noticed a spectrum of technique/talent? Do the works seem to span different eras? What do you notice about these things?
- Are you finding yourself more drawn to a certain style, technique, or subject matter? Why/why not?
- As you walk, pray for Cameron & Crystal Moberg and the Gospel Graffiti crew:
 - For continued energy and guidance as they endeavor to reflect Christ in this scene.
 - Pray for the artists – that they realize their desire to create comes directly from their Father and Creator. Pray they would learn to direct their gifts towards God in a way that transforms “expression” into “worship.”
